



**Center for Latin American and Caribbean Studies
Academic Minor Requirements**

Prerequisites

Spanish 232 OR Portuguese 232, or the equivalent.

Requirements

At least 15 credits of courses (at the 300 level and above) on Latin America and the Caribbean. The courses should be chosen from those approved by Latin America and Caribbean Studies. Please see our Undergraduate Course list for courses available.

No more than 6 of the required 15 credits may come from courses in any single department.

Only one course may be "*double-counted*" for your major and your minor.

The Academic Minor in Latin American and Caribbean Studies may not be elected by students with a concentration in Latin American and Caribbean Studies.

Students are encouraged to give coherence to the Academic Minor by discussing course elections with a departmental advisor.
