

The Department of Slavic Languages and Literatures is offering scholarships of \$500 for **Ukrainian language study at the University of Michigan** during the academic year.

**Eligibility Criteria:** Open to all U-M undergraduate students studying the Ukrainian language at the University of Michigan for one academic year. The following criteria must be fulfilled:

- Two consecutive terms of the appropriate Ukrainian language sequence;
- Courses must be taken in Fall and Winter terms; and
- Students must receive a grade of B- or better in both courses.

**Application Deadline:** Students must apply by the end of the first week of Fall term to be considered for the academic year scholarship.

**Application Submission:** Interested students should complete the application on the Slavic Department's website at **Isa.umich.edu/slavic**.

**Review Process:** Applications are reviewed by a selection committee; students will be notified of the academic year scholarship in mid-September.

**Scholarship Disbursement:** Scholarships will be disbursed at the completion of the Winter term, after grades have been submitted and evaluated.
