

Drawing in the Galleries of the Kelsey Museum of Archaeology

Please...

Do check in with security at the security desk upon arrival. They will be able to provide you with stools and clipboards as well as any specific instructions for your visit.

Do use graphite pencils and sketchbooks only. There are no exceptions to this rule. Charcoal, pastels, or liquid media are not permitted into the galleries.

Do leave all large portfolios in the coat room, along with book bags, large bags, umbrellas and coats.

Do feel free to take photographs without a flash.

Do be careful not to touch or lean against artifacts or cases.

Do leave aerosols, solvents, paint thinners, and other combustibles at home. These are not permitted in the galleries or other public spaces of the museum (including the immediately outside the entrances).

Do keep food and/or beverages outside the museum. Food (including gum) and beverages (including water) are not permitted in the galleries or coat room.

Do leave your shoes on your feet while in the galleries, for your safety.

Do keep pathways through the museum clear, especially in the area in front of the elevators, other handicap accessible entrances, and fire exits.
