Osiris

Osiris was the Egyptian god of the underworld and afterlife, and he is also associated with rebirth, having been brought back to life after death by his wife and sister, the goddess Isis. Osiris is usually shown wrapped like a mummy, and his green skin is symbolic of rebirth. He wears a special crown, called the Atef crown, with two ostrich feathers, and carries a hook and a whip, or flail.
